

Bosch's Fundraising Efforts for Children in Need.

Bosch employees have raised over £61,300 for BBC Children in Need through numerous fundraising activities.

To mark Bosch's 125th anniversary, the company decided to support Children in Need by organising various fundraising activities; from climbing the highest mountain peaks in Yorkshire, to swimming 125 lengths of a pool in 125 minutes and cycling 125 miles from Worcester to Denham.

This incredible amount has been recognised by BBC Children in Need Chief Executive, David Ramsden: "I would like to thank Bosch UK and its staff for their fundraising efforts, which really will help to improve the lives of children and young people in the UK."

The most recent charity activity was a Yorkshire Three Peaks Challenge completed by managers at the Bosch, Rexroth site. The three mountains they climbed were Pen-y-ghent (691m), Wharfedale (728m), and Ingleborough (723m) - in that order. The total climb is some 5,200 feet, and the footpaths were very wet and boggy in some places and rugged and rocky in others.

The team started at 6:45am in heavy horizontal rain, and poor visibility. They eventually completed the challenge well in to the evening and it was all worth it as they have raised over £3,000 for Children in Need.
